Requirements: (incomplete packets will not be considered for scholarship)

1. Student must complete a two-part essay, double spaced, Times New Roman 12pt font, on the following topics: (writing skills will be taken into account)

**Part I – in 500-1000 words, write an essay explaining your thoughts on volunteerism and the long and short term benefits to the community. What will you gain from this experience?
“PLEASE DO NOT DISCLOSE A PARTICULAR VOLUNTEER GROUP or a SPECIFIC GROUP THAT YOU MAY SUPPORT”**

Part II – In 250-500 words “Where do you see yourself in 20 years”?

2. Student must also submit a letter of recommendation (from a school faculty member, coach, church minister, or community leader, etc.) and a college or trade school acceptance letter.

Deadline for submission: essay must be received by Friday, March 23, 2018
