The reception will be in the lobby.

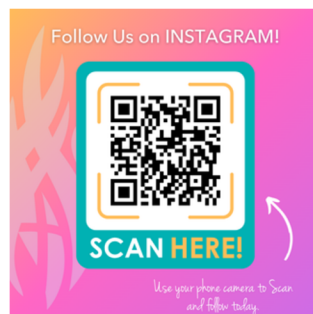
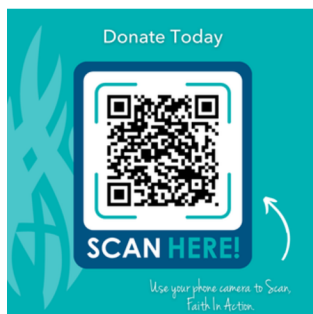
