

Lagoon Pool Rules & Regulations

(from the Residents Handbook)

WARNING: THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY (the safety and security of residents and guests is the responsibility of all adults over the age of 18 who are using the pool, the water equipment, the tiki huts and the surrounding pool area).

- Hours of operation are always after dawn until just before dusk (hours are subject to change).
- The pool is for the exclusive use of residents & their guests.
- For safety reasons and the consideration of others, residents & their guests must always comply with all pool and slide regulations.
- Residents & guests must always accept and adhere to the safety directives of pool staff.
- Please do not swallow pool water as it is re-circulated and may contain chemical properties.
- All forms of cloth and disposable diapers are prohibited.
- Children under the age of 3 and those not toilet trained are required to wear a 'swim diaper' while in the pool. See the pool attendant for swim diapers.
- All persons must shower before entering pool.

- People who are experiencing diarrhea must avoid using the pool.
 - Children under 14 years of age must always be accompanied by an adult and closely supervised.
 - Proper attire is always required (wearing thongs, 'topless' or nude bathing is prohibited).
 - Smoking is prohibited in the pool and pool area.
 - All glass containers (bottles, glasses, bowls, etc.) are prohibited in the pool and pool area.

- No food or drink is permitted in the pool or within four feet of the pool at any time.
 - No animals, except service animals, are permitted in the pool or on the pool deck. Pool staff will ask for proof of service registration for service animals.
 - Feeding of wildlife is strictly prohibited.
 - Flotation devices (except children arm floats) are prohibited.
 - Diving and jumping into the pool are prohibited.
 - Jumping the perimeter gates of the pool area is prohibited.
 - Climbing up to and jumping from the pool bridge is prohibited.
 - Beach balls are only permitted in the designated area of the pool.

- For safety reasons, running on the pool deck is prohibited.
- Throwing objects into the pool, onto the slide or on the pool deck is prohibited.
- Destruction of Sandoval property is strictly prohibited
- In the event of thunder and lightning all persons must immediately evacuate the pool and pool deck.
- Residents and guests may not confront other pool goers or cause a disturbance. All social and security infractions should be immediately reported to management or pool staff.
- Residents and guests are kindly asked to adhere to all pool safety regulations and to respect pool staff.
Insubordination, profanity, abusive language, gestures, verbal and physical threats toward staff are prohibited.
- Management and pool staff reserve the right to ask non-compliant persons to leave the pool area.
- Maximum capacity is – 179 persons.
- Pool depth is measured in feet.
- Immediately report all accidents to management.

Lap Swimming at the Lagoon Pool

Lap times have been designated at the Lagoon Pool from 8:00am to 10:00am, daily. Please respect the Sandoval lap swimmers. Be courteous and avoid the lap area during these

times. Use caution when crossing the lane area for any reason during these early morning lap hours.

Waterslide Rules

- Use of waterslide is at your own risk. The SCA is not liable for any accident or injuries.
 - Pool Staff must be on duty during slide operations.
 - All riders must be a minimum of 42" tall and must be able to swim on their own.
 - No running up the steps to the top of the waterslide; stay on the walkway.
 - Riders must wait for supervisory personnel to authorize start.
 - Proper riding position shall be lying on back, feet first, arms crossed, or hands interlocked behind head; legs crossed at the ankles.
 - No standing on slide surface at any time.
 - Only one rider at a time.
 - No life jackets, inflatable armbands, inner tubes, or eyewear are allowed.

- Riders must know how to swim and be in good general health. Persons with heart or back conditions should not ride. It is not recommended that pregnant women ride.
- Do not ride while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Quickly exit the bottom of the slide.

WARNING: Failure to follow these rules may result in serious injury or death. It is recommended riders wear appropriate protective footwear.

Courtesies and Codes of Conduct for Sandoval Lagoon Pool

- In the spirit of cooperation and goodwill, the following courtesies and codes have been formulated to create and ensure a safe, respectful, friendly, and recreational pool environment for residents, their guests, and Sandoval Staff. Everyone who is in the pool area is expected to adhere to posted pool rules, to refrain from using profanity or displaying loud boisterous behavior, and to conduct themselves in a manner that contributes to a climate of relaxed recreation which is reflective of a family-friendly environment.

- Sandoval Staff is required by Florida Department of Health regulations to enforce all pool safety rules. Residents and their guests are required to comply promptly and respectfully to all safety directives given by Sandoval Staff.
 - Verbal or physical intimidation or menacing behavior is prohibited. Sandoval Staff is authorized to direct disruptive and non-compliant persons to leave the Lagoon Pool area

for the duration of that day. Violation of the pool regulations could result in a longer period of suspension of Lagoon Pool utilization.

- Any concerns regarding non-compliance of pool rules or inappropriate social behaviors should be brought to the attention of Sandoval Staff for review and resolution. Residents should report their concerns to Staff and refrain from confronting people who are non-compliant.
