

News from the CCRPC GIS Team:

- 1) [The VCGI Imagery Program](#) acquired black & white, color and color infrared imagery of Chittenden County in the Spring of 2018. After acquisition, the data was then post-processed, and quality checked before it was released. CCRPC received the data at the end of December. All of Chittenden County's imagery was acquired at 15 cm resolution, equal to the 2013 acquisition. The quality and clarity of the imagery is fantastic! CCRPC GIS staff will be working over the next few weeks to distribute the digital imagery to all municipalities. The data is available in GeoTiff or Jpeg2000 tiles. We can mosaic all tiles per town into one image file and/or provide the individual tiles. Caution, there are a lot of tiles – It takes 160 tiles to cover Essex & Essex Junction. Another way to access the individual tiles is through the Vermont Open Data Portal (http://geodata.vermont.gov/datasets?t=datasetVTORTHO_0_15M_PAN_2018). Future Land Use data for all Regional Planning Commissions can be found on the Open Data Portal. All Chittenden County Zoning and Zoning Overlay data is also available from the Open Data Portal. In December, CCRPC staff reviewed current zoning regulations to verify the most current GIS data is available on the portal the data description is linked to the zoning regulations document.
