WELCOME GUEST SPEAKER: Jacob Reitan For the Bible Tells Me So

After graduating from Northwestern University in 2004, Mankato native, Jacob Reitan used a Presidential Scholarship to attend Harvard Divinity School where he received a Masters in Theological Studies. He subsequently attended law school at the University of Minnesota, graduating magna cum laude.

Prior to starting his legal career, Jacob worked as an advocate for the gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender community. As a part of this work, Jacob founded the Equality Ride and the Right to Serve Campaign. In 2006, Jacob was invited by the White House to be with President Obama when he signed the repeal of the “Don’t Ask, Don’t Tell” law. In 2012, Governor Dayton named Jacob to the Governor’s Task Force on the Prevention of School Bullying. For his advocacy Jacob has been awarded the Brian Coyle Leadership Award from the Human Rights Campaign, and he has been named one of the people of the year by Advocate Magazine and Lavender Magazine.

Jacob joined his father and brother at Reitan Law Office in 2014.
