SAVE MONEY ON FUEL AND MAINTENANCE WITH A ZERO-EMISSION VEHICLE

Transitioning your vehicles and fleets to electric reduces fuel and maintenance costs. You can receive up to \$3,000 off the purchase or lease of a new zero-emission vehicle. Funding for workplace charging stations, fleets and more charging stations across B.C. make it easier to transition to electric vehicles. Transitioning your fleet is good for business and good for the planet.

COMBINE PROVINCIAL AND FEDERAL PROGRAMS TO GET UP TO \$8,000 IN INCENTIVES

Save up to \$8,000 on a new zero-emission vehicle with the Federal Government's iZEV program. In addition, the Federal Budget 2019 proposed a 100-per-cent tax write-off for zero-emission vehicles business purchases, offering a deductible up to a limit of \$55,000 plus sales tax for eligible vehicles.
