

JA Central Ontario Virtual Company Program Fixed Costs & Profits Tax 2021-2022

Fixed Costs

During the 2021-2022 cycle each virtual company program will be required to pay the fixed costs associated with running a business.

Through the implementation of fixed costs students are given a real-world perspective on the expenses associated with running and operating a small business. Companies should incorporate this cost when they plan their initial budget.

The total amount of the fixed costs per company is **\$150.00** – which will be invoiced in 2 installments.

The first installment for \$75.00 is due on Friday, January 21, 2022. The second installment for \$75.00 is due on Friday, April 8, 2022.

Sales Profits Tax

All sales profits tax payments must be submitted no later than Friday, April 8, 2022.

Calculation of Sales Profits Tax:

(Total Sales/Revenue) - (Total Expenses) = Income before Profits Tax (Income before Profits Tax) x (10%) = Profits Tax (Income before Profits Tax) - (Profits Tax) = Net Income *Net Income is what is used to calculate final ROI figures.

Example:

\$5400 (Sales/Revenue) – \$4100 (Expenses) =\$ 1300 (Profit) \$1300 (Profit) x 10% (Profits Tax Percentage Payable) =\$130 (profits tax due) \$1300- \$130 = \$1170 (net income)

Total Expenses may include:

Salaries, Commissions, Marketing and Incentives, Office Supplies, Bank Charges, Shareholders Report, Charitable Donations, Other Expenses.

If a company has made less than \$500 profit overall, they will <u>not be required</u> to submit profits tax to JA Central Ontario.



HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR PAYMENT

Both fixed costs as well as sales profits tax payments MUST be submitted by the appropriate due dates in order for companies to be eligible for any of the Company Program awards.
