


Average Case Assignment Length

### CASA Advocates are:

- Specially Trained with a 30 hour initial training followed by 12 hours of continued education yearly
- Sworn in as Friends of the Court
- Supervised by Professional Staff
- Dedicated to meeting with the child until their case is closed
- A Consistent presence to leave positive lasting impact
