Youth Mobile Crisis Services

The New Oakland Youth Mobile Crisis Team's mission is to:

- Provide rapid mobile response to children and youth in crisis
- Stabilize emotional and/or behavioral functioning
- Provide assessment and coordination for continued stabilization
- Connect individuals and families to services

What are examples of a crisis?

- Aggression
- Property destruction
- Dangerous or Impulsive decision-making
- Threatening behaviors
- Loss of coping skills
- Social isolation
- Self-harm
- Suicidal thoughts

The Mobile Crisis Team travels throughout Oakland County and meets youth and families where they are, in the community; at home, a park, or another public gathering place.

** Deployment of the team is based on the supports determined to stabilize a crisis situation in an effort to maintain the child or youths' current living arrangement.*
