Orange and Black day on Halloween. Costumes are not worn to school for grades K-8 on Halloween. Students may wear orange or black for Halloween. They may also wear Spirit Wear on Halloween. All out-of-uniform days must follow our handbook stated out-of-uniform guidelines. Students who do not follow the guidelines will be required to change into their school uniform.

No shorts after this Friday until April 1st. As stated in the handbook, shorts may not be worn from November 1st to March 31st. A few reminders about uniform pants:

- **Donald's Uniforms is our official uniform store.** The clothing Donald's offers is the official uniform and the standard/quality which is to be followed. Anything not from Donald's must be the same color and style.
- Grades K-5
 - Plaid Jumper
 - Plaid Skirt
 - Donald's navy blue cotton twill dress pants- no cargo, athletic, or skinny styles
 - Navy leggings or tights may only be worn under a uniform jumper or skirt.
- Grades 6th-8th
 - Donald's navy blue or khaki dress pants- no cargo, athletic, or skinny styles
 - For female students only-Donald's navy blue or khaki hipster skort
 - Navy leggings or tights may only be worn under a uniform skirt.

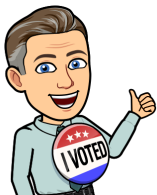
As the weather gets cooler, please remember that we send kids out for recess daily unless it is raining, the temperature is below 0°, or the "feels like" temp is below -10°.
