# New Jersey Association for Lifelong Learning NJALL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2021

## **Application Eligibility and Contents**

#### NJALL WILL AWARD SCHOLARSHIPS ON JUNE 18, 2021, TO \*TWO ELIGIBLE ADULTS.

\* If funding is available, a 3<sup>rd</sup> scholarship may be awarded.

The NJALL Scholarship provides funds directly to the winner, up to a maximum of \$8,000, in support of higher education. \$1,000 is provided per semester for full-time enrollment, (12 credits or more) and pro-rated for part-time enrollment. (Example: \$500 for 6 credits) Funds up to \$1,000 are provided for 12 credits/or more taken during combined summer or winter sessions.

\*Bonus Awards: Completion of Associate's Degree - \$500; Completion of Bachelor's Degree -\$1000

Scholarship applications are open to eligible adults regardless of Gender, race, color, religion, age, sexual orientation/identification or disabling condition.

#### To be Eligible You Must:

- 1. Be a resident of New Jersey.
- 2. Have earned a NJ High School Diploma by attending a NJ adult education program to prepare for a High School Equivalency Exam (GED, TASC or HiSET) or to complete Adult HS requirements. (Not limited to those who earned diplomas during this year.)
- 3. Have been accepted to/or attending an accredited post-secondary institution.
- **4.** Complete and Sign your Application.
- 5. Include ALL Required Documents listed below:
  - **a.** Copy of High School Equivalency Test scores (GED,TASC or HiSET) \*Or Copy of Adult High School Transcript.
  - **b.** Copy of your High School Diploma.
  - **c.** Proof of acceptance to an accredited post-secondary institution \* Or Official College Transcript, if currently attending college.
  - d. Two (2) letters of recommendation addressing your motivation, goals, ability to meet educational and life challenges and your potential for success in higher education. NOTE: At least one letter must be attached to a completed "Educational Recommendation" form (page 4) included in the application
  - **6.** SUBMIT the Completed Signed Application with all required supporting materials By **US Mail**, **postmarked** no later than: **Monday**, **May 10**, **2021**

Note: Scholarship winners are required to submit an official transcript of grades at the end of each semester as well as registration documentation at the beginning of each semester.
