



Greetings from Miss Hall's School! As a follow-up to the Family Communication, boarding students and families are asked to provide information about student travel plans so that we may coordinate a safe, smooth, and accessible campus arrival for all.

Please log into your MyBackPack Account and complete the Student Travel Form - Fall 2020. Please complete this form by Sunday, August 9th.

For the purposes of this communication and the Student Travel Form - Fall 2020 students will need to indicate what group represents their situation.

Group 1: International students, students who must fly, or students traveling by car/bus/train from states other than New York, New Jersey, or the New England states will need to arrive between August 24-28.

Group 2: Students traveling by car from New England, New York, and New Jersey will need to arrive between September 2-5.

Group 3: Students impacted by travel restrictions or flight availability and will not be returning to campus before September 5th.

Group 4: Students choosing not to return to campus at this time and will be an online learner.

Information for Group 1

Students in Group 1 will provide flight and travel information and can arrive at any time between August 24-28.

Information for Group 2

Students in Group 2 will provide information about days and times that the student's family will be available to bring students to campus between September 2-5. To ensure that we maintain safe arrival for all, we will confirm the arrival date and time window with each family the week of August 17th. If necessary, we will work with students and families to ensure their arrival date and time window is accessible and safe.

Information for Group 3

Students in Group 3 will be asked to provide the most up to date information they have about possible campus arrival.

Information for Group 4

Students in Group 4 will be contacted by the School to confirm plans.

Transportation Information

If a student needs help arranging transportation from an airport or bus/train station they need to provide all the necessary information to the School as soon as possible. The School will be working with outside transportation companies to provide any and all transportation from an airport or bus/train station. Transportation costs will vary based on pick-up location and the number of students needing transportation. Families can expect transportation costs to be higher than normal.
