Hunterdon County Commissioners Host NJ MVC Mobile Unit To Assist Local Residents

On Tuesday, October 14th, the New Jersey Motor Vehicle (NJMVC) Mobile Unit made a successful stop at the Route 12 County Complex in Flemington, delivering a full range of vital motor vehicle services directly to the residents of Hunterdon County. The event, held from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm, saw a strong turnout of residents who benefited from both scheduled appointments and walk-up services.

Commissioner Zach Rich shared, “This is exactly the kind of service that makes a difference in people’s lives. We understand that not everyone can easily make it to a full-service MVC location – so bringing these services, especially REAL IDS, directly to the Route 12 Complex helps our residents expedite needed services close to home. I want to thank NJMVC and our county staff for making the mobile unit event a success.”

The mobile unit, fully ADA accessible, offered REAL ID applications, registration renewals, duplicate or replacement titles and registrations, license plate surrenders, and issuance of handicapped, veteran, and Purple Heart placards. Red Graduated Driver License decals were also available for purchase.

REAL IDS have been required since May 7th, 2025, for anyone wishing to fly domestically or enter federal buildings without a passport.

Commissioner Rich added, “Hunterdon County remains committed to making government more accessible and efficient to the needs of our residents by bringing essential state services directly to our community - where they’re needed most.”
