

Mallinckrodt Pharmaceuticals Joins Hunterdon County's Economic Roster

Hunterdon County is welcoming Mallinckrodt Pharmaceuticals, another life science and bio sector company, to the lineup of similar businesses that have chosen to locate in the County, Commissioner Matt Holt announced at the February 2nd Board of County Commissioners meeting.

Holt, the Board's Economic Development liaison, reported, "Mallinckrodt Pharmaceuticals is a multi-billion dollar, innovation-driven, specialty pharmaceutical company whose history dates back into the 19th century. Their expansion into the Perryville III facility in Union Township along I-78 is most welcome."

Holt stated, "The Perryville III site, owned by Shelbourne Global, has become home over the last few years to Celldex, New Jersey Economic Development Authority incubator spin off Visikol, Celldex Therapeutics, and Linde Electronics.

The location again demonstrates the success of the County's strategy to encourage the re-use of existing commercial assets, as an alternative to the construction of new facilities. It is an exceptional site that we expect will contribute to the local economy for years to come."

Holt said, "We are also pleased to learn that Shelbourne Global's Vice President for Leasing has said that one of his most productive partnerships is with Hunterdon County Economic Development."

Shelbourne Global is a New York based company that owns and manages over 8,000,000 square feet of Commercial Real Estate, totaling over a billion dollars' worth of assets.

Commissioner Holt added, "The success of this site attracting the life & bio sector, along with the recent addition of the UNICOM Global Science and Technology Park in Readington Township, ExxonMobil's existing international R&D facility in Clinton Township, and more, is giving Hunterdon County a true tech corridor along Interstate 78.
