

Hunterdon Sheriff Warns Residents Of Recent Scams

'Hang Up And Don't Share Personal Information'

Hunterdon County Sheriff Frederick W. Brown has recently been receiving calls from residents reporting utility scams. JCP&L and PSE&G scam calls have been made with threats of electricity being turned off in thirty minutes without immediate payment.

Sheriff Brown reminds residents that neither utility would call customers to demand money.

Residents are also reporting a letter sent by mail advising of a tax "Distraint Warrant" which looks official but is also a scam. Always contact the IRS or local tax boards to verify a demand of payment before sending a check.
