CrimeStoppers Annual Awards Night**

The evening’s highlight was the recognition of Hunterdon County Prosecutor Renée M. Robeson as the *2025 Hunterdon County CrimeStopper of the Year*.

This annual event celebrates the achievements of individuals and law enforcement officers who demonstrate outstanding service and commitment to public safety. Since her appointment in 2021, Prosecutor Robeson has led numerous initiatives to modernize investigative practices, improve community engagement, and enhance victim-centered approaches to justice.

During her tenure, the Hunterdon County Prosecutor’s Office achieved accreditation from the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police, a reflection of her dedication to excellence, accountability, and innovation in public service.

The event also acknowledged members of local law enforcement for their service and highlighted the important role of CrimeStoppers in community-based crime prevention. CSHC is a volunteer-run, nonprofit organization that operates solely on donations and offers rewards to individuals who provide anonymous tips that lead to arrests and indictments.
