RENÉE ROBESON SWORN IN AS HUNTERDON COUNTY PROSECUTOR

On July 1, 2021, Renée Robeson was sworn in as Hunterdon County Prosecutor at the Historic Courthouse in Flemington. The ceremony was presided over by the Honorable Judge Thomas Miller, Assignment Judge for Vicinage 13, Somerset/Hunterdon/Warren Counties.

Following the oath of office, Prosecutor Robeson stated, "We are at a moment in America's history when those of us entrusted with the administration of justice, at every level, must do more in every way to establish and maintain the trust of those we serve. This requires renewed diligence, transparency, and effort. I understand that great trust comes with my office and I look forward to exerting every ounce of my energy to serving Justice, for our State, for our County, and for the team I lead and the public I work to protect."

A lifelong resident of Hunterdon County, Prosecutor Robeson said it was a dream come true to serve the community that her family calls home. Prior to becoming prosecutor, she served as an Assistant Prosecutor in Mercer County for over 17 years.

The ceremony was attended by many dignitaries including, District 22 State Senator Nicholas P. Scutari, District 16 Senator Christopher "Kip" Bateman, District 16 Assemblyman Roy Freiman, Hunterdon County Commissioners Director Susan Soloway and Deputy Director John E. Lanza and Mercer County Prosecutor, Angelo J. Onofri. During her address to the attendees, she expressed her deepest appreciation to Governor Phil Murphy, Attorney General Gurbir Grewal, and the members of their staffs for entrusting her with such an important post.

Board of Commissioners Deputy Director Lanza, the Board's liaison for Public Safety, said, "The new Prosecutor brings tremendous experience to the post. This is an excellent appointment and the Board looks forward to a great working relationship with our newest Constitutional officer."
