Hunterdon County 9/11 Ceremony Will Honor Lives Lost And Ground Zero Response

Hunterdon County Sheriff Fred W. Brown will be joined by County Prosecutor Anthony P. Kearns, III, and law enforcement officials and first responders from around the County, at the Hunterdon County September 11th Remembrance Ceremony, on the Historic Courthouse steps, in Flemington, at 8:15 am, on September 11, 2018.

Sheriff Brown re-instituted the County Remembrance ceremony in 2017, pledging to make it an annual event.

"This ceremony is important. America must always remember and never forget the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001, that took the lives of nearly 3000 individuals. And it is of particular import to us here in Hunterdon County, where sixteen residents were lost," the Sheriff said.

The ceremonies will feature remarks by retired Raritan Police Officer and West Amwell Township resident Gary Breuer, regarding emergency response activities at ground zero immediately after the attack.

Mr. Breuer is a member of the New Jersey State Police's Office of Emergency Management Task Force 1, a statewide unit trained for crisis response, that spent ten days on site at ground zero, immediately after the attack in 2001.

Chiefs and officers from many Police Departments, Rescue Squads, Volunteer Fire Companies, and Veterans have been invited to participate in the ceremonies.

Sheriff Brown noted, "Special acknowledgment is due to all the first responders and law enforcement officers who responded on September 11, 2001, and who stand ready today to serve and protect their fellow citizens."

The public is invited to attend the ceremony.
