PRESENTATION OF THE CANDIDATES

The Celebrant says to the Parents and Godparents:

Celebrant Parents and godparents, the Church receives these children with joy. Today we are trusting God for their growth in faith. Will you pray for them, draw them by your example into the community of faith, and walk with them in the way of Christ?

Parents & Godparents With the help of God, we will.

Celebrant In baptism these children will begin their journey in faith. You speak for them today. Will you care for them, and help them to take their place within the life and worship of Christ's Church?

Parents & Godparents With the help of God, we will.

Celebrant Therefore I ask: Do you turn to Christ?

Parents & Godparents I turn to Christ.

Celebrant Do you repent of your sins?

Parents & Godparents I repent of my sins.

Celebrant Do you renounce evil?

Parents & Godparents I renounce evil.

The Celebrant addresses the congregation, saying:

Celebrant Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support these children in their life in Christ?

People **We will!**

PROFESSION OF FAITH

Celebrant Let us affirm, together with these who are being baptized, our common faith in Jesus Christ. Do you believe and trust in God the Father, source of all being and life, the one for whom we exist?

People **I believe and trust in God.**

Celebrant Do you believe and trust in God the Son, who took our human nature, died for us and rose again?

People **I believe and trust in God.**

Celebrant Do you believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit, who gives life to the people of God and makes Christ known in the world?

People **I believe and trust in God.**

Celebrant This is the faith of the Church.

People **This is our faith. We believe and trust in one God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.**

PRAYERS OVER THE WATER

The family gathers at the baptismal font.

Celebrant Praise God who made heaven and earth,

People **Who keeps his promise for ever.**

Celebrant Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

People **It is right to give thanks and praise.**

WE thank you, almighty God, for the gift of water to sustain, refresh, and cleanse all life. Over water the Holy Spirit moved in the beginning of creation. Through water you led the children of Israel from slavery in Egypt to freedom in the Promised Land. In water your Son Jesus received the baptism of John and was anointed by the Holy Spirit as the Messiah, the Christ, to lead us from the death of sin to newness of life.

We thank you, O God, for the water of baptism. In it we are buried with Christ in his death. By it we share in his resurrection. Through it we are reborn by the Holy Spirit. Therefore, in joyful obedience to your Son, we baptize into his fellowship those who come to him in faith.

Now sanctify this water that, by the power of your Holy Spirit, they may be cleansed from sin and born again. Renewed in your image, may they walk by the light of faith and continue forever in the risen life of Jesus Christ our Lord; to whom with you and the Holy Spirit be all honor and glory, now and forever. **Amen.**

THE BAPTISM

Celebrant _____, I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen.**

May God, who has received you by baptism into God's Church, pour upon you the riches of God's grace, that within the company of Christ's pilgrim people you may daily be renewed by God's anointing Spirit, and come to the inheritance of the saints in glory. **Amen.**

_____, you are sealed by the Holy Spirit in Baptism and marked as Christ's own forever. **Amen.**

PRESENTATION OF THE CANDLE

Celebrant Let us welcome the newly baptized.

People **We receive you into the household of God. Confess the faith of Christ crucified, proclaim his resurrection, and share with us in his eternal priesthood.**

THE PEACE

Celebrant The peace of Christ be always with you.

People **And also with you.**

Celebrant The Lord be with you.

AND now we give you thanks because you anointed Jesus Christ, your only Son, as the eternal priest and King of all. As a priest he offered up his life on the cross, that by his one sacrifice he might present to you an eternal kingdom: a kingdom of truth and life; a kingdom of justice, love, and peace. And so with angels and archangels and all the heavenly host, we proclaim your glory, and join their unending hymn of praise:

We thank you, loving God, because, when we turned away, you sent Jesus, your Son. He gave his life for us on the cross and shows us the way to live. Send your Holy Spirit that these gifts of bread and wine may be for us Christ's body and his blood. On the night before he died, when darkness had fallen, Jesus took bread. He gave thanks, broke it, and shared it with his disciples, saying: "This is my body, given for you. Do this to remember me." After they had eaten, he took the cup of wine, gave thanks, and shared it with his disciples, saying: "This is my blood, poured out for you and for many, for the forgiveness of sins."

So God, with this bread and this cup we celebrate his love, his death, his risen life. As you feed us with these gifts, send your Holy Spirit, and change us more and more to be like Jesus our Savior. Help us, God, to love one another, as we look forward to that day when suffering is ended, and all creation is gathered in your loving arms. And now with Bartholomew and all your saints we give you glory, through Jesus Christ, in the strength of the Spirit, today and for ever. **Amen.**
