HDVI offers insurance savings to commercial trucking fleets

According to the Michigan Trucking Association, there are 19,750 trucking companies located in Michigan, and they are primarily small, locally owned businesses.

Drivers are also engaged through the HDVI Driver+ mobile app, where they can earn rewards and receive valuable safety information.

Six insurance agencies currently sell HDVI insurance to trucking fleets in Michigan, including HNI Risk Services of Michigan.

"Safety is a priority for fleet customers, as is reducing operating costs, and we're continually looking for opportunities to help them meet those goals," said Nathan Steffen, President, HNI Risk Services of Michigan. "Many of our customers invest significant time and resources into the safety of their fleets and HDVI's innovative, telematics-driven approach will both enhance their efforts as well as help them more quickly realize a return on investment."

HDVI's insurance is compatible with most modern ELDs and cameras, but if a fleet's current hardware is not compatible, HDVI will replace it at no additional cost.

HDVI is currently available in nine states, including Alabama, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Ohio, Tennessee, and Texas, and is focused on small and midsized trucking fleets. The company plans to be in 25 states by the end of 2022.
