

Hwy 19/College Drive Marshall Reconstruction

Project Summary

The Minnesota Department of Transportation will be reconstructing Hwy 19/College Drive from 4th Street to Bruce Street in the city of Marshall. The pavement has deteriorated and the city needs to replace aging utilities. Sidewalk improvements will be made along the project area in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

The overall project details are not yet determined. Through the project development phase (now – Jan. 2020) overall project details will be determined. Discussions about lane widths, options for intersection controls, streetscape and aesthetic options, drainage, and other project details, will take place during this phase. The project development phase of the project is key in developing a preliminary design layout and ultimately the final design and construction plans.

The project is anticipated to go out for bids in the fall of 2024. Construction is expected to begin spring of 2025 and will take one full construction season to complete.
