



Summary of Recent Covid-19 Changes (May/June 2021)

Per guidance and regulations of The Colorado Department of Health Care Policy and Financing,
Colorado Department of Public Health and Colorado Department of Human Services

Many of the changes establish different expectations for Fully Vaccinated vs. Unvaccinated/Partially Vaccinated people. Voluntary mask wearing is permitted. Services will still be delivered virtually in some cases.

DDRC Area/Audience	Summary of Changes and Restrictions Still in Place
Day Services (Group)	Masks required for unvaccinated or partially vaccinated participants, visitors and employees, however participants with medical documentation of inability to wear a mask are exempt. Continue daily screenings and temperature checks for visitors and employees.
Early Intervention	If all parties are vaccinated, masks are optional for in-person visits and ALL parties must agree. If all parties do not agree to no masks for in person visits, the visit must occur virtually or with masks being worn. Observe physical distancing for adults. Service Coordination continues to be virtual. All parties must agree for evaluations to be in-person, and visits are limited (frequency/duration), otherwise services are offered virtually.
Group Homes	Continue daily screenings including temperature checks for visitors and employees. Continue daily monitoring for residents. Surveillance testing for unvaccinated or partially vaccinated. Unvaccinated or partially vaccinated visitors must schedule visitation time, wear a mask, observe physical distancing and other Covid-19 related protective measures. Verification of Full Vaccination Required for: optional mask wearing, drop-by visits and participation in group activities.
Individual Residential Services and Supports	Masks required for unvaccinated or partially vaccinated staff.
Resource Coordination (Case Management)	In person meetings at the discretion of the organization. DDRC is not implementing in person visits at this time.
Other Staff/Areas & Individual Supported Employment	Masks required for unvaccinated or partially vaccinated visitors and employees.
Transportation	Masks required for unvaccinated or partially vaccinated participants, visitors and employees, however participants with medical documentation of inability to wear a mask are exempt.
