

TRIAD JUMP START CHILD CARE SUBSIDY PROGRAM

Starting a new job and need help paying for childcare?

The Triad Early Childhood Council is excited to announce the availability of funding made possible by the Colorado Dept. of Early Childhood Community Innovation and Resilience for Care and Learning Equity (CIRCLE) grant program. This funding will assist families by providing a 3-month child care subsidy.

How does it work?

This subsidy provides graduated child care funding for workers going back to work or school who do not qualify for CCCAP. All licensed and registered providers who are caring for recipients' children are able to participate with 100% of the cost being covered in the first month, 75% in the second month, and 50% in the third month. Recipients must meet the following requirements:

Be newly employed or enrolled in a school or job training

Have a child o-8 years

Live within Clear Creek or Gilpin County

Not qualify for CCCAP or other subsidies
