SUBJECT: Current COVID Guidance

EI Colorado is no longer issuing guidance related to COVID restrictions. This means that early intervention (EI) activities may take place in person and includes EI services; service coordination activities; Individualized Family Service Plan meetings; and evaluations conducted by Community Centered Boards.

While in-person meetings are permitted they are not required, and EI Colorado continues to support and encourage all families and professionals who prefer to meet virtually to do so. EI direct service providers are expected to follow any requirements of their professional organizations or other regulatory authority over their work.

Any decisions regarding any future guidance will be determined by mandatory state and health guidelines as circumstances dictate. Thank you for your understanding and patience during the challenges of the last two years.

This guidance takes the place of all communication sent out previously and will be in effect March 31, 2022.
