SNAP & Medicaid Eligibility Updates

New federal law will impact future benefits for some customers

WHO WILL BE AFFECTED?	REQUIREMENTS
Most Able-Bodied Adults Without Dependents (ABAWDs) • Age 64 and under	For SNAP • Will need to work 80 hours/month
	For Medicaid Will need to work, go to school or volunteer at least 80 hours/month
Parents (Eligible for Benefits)	For SNAP • If youngest child is 14+ years old, Parents will need to work 80 hours/month
	For Medicaid • If youngest child is 14+ years old, Parents will need to work, go to school or volunteer at least 80 hours/month
Non-Citizens Without Legal Status • Most immigrants without a green card or citizenship	Will no longer be eligible for SNAP or Medicaid

However, there are no changes today, so applicants should continue to submit applications and members should submit their renewals and continue to get access to care.
