Intro to Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) in the Home and Community

This class will be in-person and masks are required, unless otherwise noted upon arrival. If the class needs to move to a virtual format an invitation/ Zoom code will be provided. IT support is not available.

This two-day training will provide a better understanding as to the process of how human behavior is created, maintained, and improved. The training should help staff, caregivers, and family make decisions for possible behavior motivation. The training provides added understanding to the behavioral principles already outlined in behavior plans. After the training, attendees will be able to identify key elements needed to improve behavioral supports and provide a more rounded behavioral support themselves. The training will include the foundations of behavior, prevention strategies, and intervention strategies. This training does not instruct on physical restraint management. Attendance on the first day is necessary to continue in the second day of training. A minimum of 5 attendees is required to hold the training.

Trainer: This training is conducted by DDRC's Behavioral Health Team Manager - Zach Maple. Zach is a Board Certified Behavior Analyst and Licensed Professional Counselor. Zach has been working in the field of behavior analysis since 2008 and has experience working with multiple populations within the lifespan. He has also published research in the application of ABA interventions.

Target Audience: This training is best suited for parents, caregivers, residential staff, day program staff, teachers, respite providers or other providers in the community that are waiting to receive behavioral supports, need minimal behavioral supports, or want to learn the basics of and more about ABA. This is not a college level course.
