## Who can attend Business Exploration Club?

If you decide you would like support finding a job, we can connect you with DDRC's employment team to discuss your options.

## What if I don't want a job?

Employment is a personal choice. BEC welcomes anyone interested in learning about local businesses and employment regardless of their desire to pursue employment.

#### What activities will BEC offer?

We will organize a variety of programming options based on participant interest. This will include activities such as touring local businesses, informational interviews with employees/employers, in-house skills workshops, and guest speakers. We are open to new ideas! Come ready to share your thoughts and help shape your own experience.
