Keep in mind the following list of acceptable items:

Clothes and shoes: Any article of clothing or shoes, including outerwear (even mittens, gloves, boots/shoes and socks that don't have a pair!)

Accessories: Handbags, neckties, scarves, belts, backpacks, fanny packs, wallets, other bags

Other items you might not think about, but are accepted:

Uniforms, costumes, fabric/fabric scraps, bathrobes, cloth napkins, pillowcases, kitchen towels, bath towels, drapes, curtains, sheets, blankets, comforters, duvet covers, tablecloths, pot holders, sofa and chair covers

**All items are accepted in any condition – anything that cannot be worn/used will be recycled*
