

## **Weekend Camping / Outdoor Activity Opportunities For Scouts at Camp McDowell**

Camp McDowell is located at 105 DeLong Road, Nauvoo, Alabama – between Jasper and Double Springs. Clear Creek, which passes through Camp McDowell, flows into the western side of Smith Lake. The Camp is owned by the Episcopal Diocese of Alabama and has operated as a camp for nearly 100 years. The web address is [campmcdowell.com](http://campmcdowell.com).

Camp McDowell is excited to offer weekend outings at Camp McDowell to Scout Packs (or Dens) and Scout Troops.

### *Tent Camping at Camp McDowell – ideal for Scouts BSA:*

- Camp in the “pasture” – a large open, flat field bordered by woods
  - Enjoy the fire ring / pit at the edge of the pasture, which is ideal for campfires
  - Enjoy the permanent outdoor grill at the edge of the pasture
  - The nearby field house provides flush toilets and sinks
  - Ready access to treated water
- Access to all outdoor facilities at Camp McDowell is included
  - Canoes for use on Lake Sloan (5 or 6 acres), or on Clear Creek
  - Fishing on Lake Sloan or Clear Creek
  - Hiking trails
- Sunday morning Church services may be available in the beautiful Chapel of St. Francis
- Service work opportunities are available
- Access to certain indoor facilities, such as the Council House (indoor amphitheater with a fire ring in the middle, and a hole in the roof for smoke to escape – great place for a campfire), subject to availability
- \$15 per camper per night – this assumes the campers do not use indoor kitchens for cooking and cleaning

### *Cabin Stays at Lower Camp at Camp McDowell – ideal for Cub Packs or Dens:*

- Adults and Scouts would stay in cabins that contain bunks and full bathrooms
  - Bunks would be spaced to provide COVID distancing
- Access to indoor kitchens for meal preparation
- Access to all outdoor facilities at Camp McDowell is included (as appropriate for Cub Scouts)
- Sunday morning Church services may be available in the beautiful Chapel of St. Francis
- Service work opportunities are available
- Access to certain indoor facilities, such as the Council House, subject to availability
- \$25 per camper per night, plus \$1 per camper for indoor food prep
