What essentials do we need to bring?

Please prepare as if you were sleeping in the wild. Bring a tent, sleeping bag, pillows, flashlight, proper clothes, and a light jacket for a chilly night.

Who receives Scout patches?

All participants in the Camp portion of the Scout Night will receive a commemorative patch. These patches will be given to the Troop leader who books your outing prior to the event date. All patch requests must come from the Troop leader responsible for booking.

Is the Camp out open to friends and family?

Yes!! Friends, family and siblings are all encouraged to join us at Regions Fields for the night. All sleepover participants will be required to have a Chaperone/Additional Guest Sleepover ticket.

Where do scouts store their camping gear?

Scouts will need to keep their gear in their chaperones/leaders' vehicle during the duration of the game. After the game, all participants will have the ability to exit the stadium and re-enter with their belongings.

If we need to leave in the middle of the night, can we?

Itinerary

ARRIVAL & GAME: Scout Leaders will have both tickets and patches prior to game date. Gates will open at 6:00 pm with scouts having access to the stadium at this time. All scouts are encouraged to use our Parkside Entry on 1st Ave South across from Railroad Park.

SLEEPOVER: Once the stadium is cleared of fans (including Scouts) and the Grounds Crew has given the greenlight, all scouts will be able to re-enter Regions Field and begin set-up. Tent set up will be permitted ONLY ON THE OUTFIELD. Following set-up, a movie will be played with the stadium lights being turned off at the end of the movie. There will always be (2) Barons staff members on premises.

MORNING and CLEAN-UP: Wake-up call will be at 6:30 AM, camping gear must be removed from the field no later than 7:30 AM. A table will be set up for scouts to receive a breakfast item and drink on their way out of the stadium. Prior to exit, all participants are REQUIRED to assist in cleaning up their camping area. NO DEBRIS or items may remain on the field, cleaning the field ensures this event can be a part of the Barons baseball experience for years to come!
