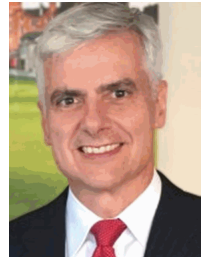

Biographical Information

David McIntosh is president of the Club for Growth, the leading advocate for economic liberty. Former Congressman David McIntosh represented Indiana's 2nd Congressional District in the United States Congress from 1995-2001. Before that, he served in the Reagan Administration as special assistant to Attorney General Edwin Meese III and special assistant to President Reagan for Domestic Affairs. During the first Bush Administration, he served as executive director of the President's Council on Competitiveness and assistant to the Vice President. David is a co-founder of the Federalist Society for Law and Public Policy and serves on the Board of Directors. He is a coordinating committee member and former chairman of the Conservative Action Project (CAP). He has also had stints at the Hudson Institute and as a Professor of Economics at Ball State School of Business. Prior to the Club for Growth, David was a partner at Mayer Brown, LLP in Washington, D.C.
