- Using a computer at home, <u>minor participants</u> will complete tasks of cognitive skills (like attention) and fill out short surveys about their everyday behaviors, mindsets, and beliefs
- A <u>parent/guardian</u> will also fill out brief surveys about their child
- The participant's participation will take approximately 1 hour
