Focused Research Award: Applications related to the four Thematic Areas of the CEET: Air Pollution & Lung Health; Environmental Exposures & Cancer; Windows-of-Susceptibility; and Environmental Neuroscience

Opportunity Award: Applications proposing innovative research and technologies in Environmental Health Sciences

- **Awards up to \$50,000 for a 6 or 12-month project period**
 - **6-month award - Deadline: Friday, November 14, 2025**
 - **12-month award - Deadline: Friday, January 16, 2026**
- Any standing or research faculty from any University of Pennsylvania School may apply
- No salary support for the faculty member is allowable
