

What is Common Space?

WHAT IT IS: Common Space is a weekly dialogue around the origins, interpretations, and universal truths of the stories of the Bible. It is an open and critically honest look at the Bible. Hosted by AHUMC pastors, Common Space is a group of people asking questions and talking about the issues and perspectives that matter to them today.

WHAT IT IS NOT: Common Space is not a traditional Bible study. There is no homework. There is no agenda—other than the aforementioned critically honest look at the Bible for what it really is.

WHAT HAPPENS: Each week, participants receive a short handout pertaining to a particular biblical story or issue. We read the handout together out-loud with volunteer readers being invited to comment on what they read before the discussion is opened up. Differing insights and viewpoints are not only welcome, they are encouraged—as are all questions.
