



COVID-19 Test & Trace

CFLSP's ongoing COVID-19 outreach and education initiative continues to provide informational flyers and face masks daily to CFLSP food pantry and tax preparation clients, as well as other community members. In a typical week, we provide over 800 face masks and 500 flyers to clients.

While COVID-19 testing remains important, and there are a number of testing options in the Sunset Park community, New York City is focusing its efforts on ensuring as many New Yorkers as possible have the information they need to get a COVID-19 vaccine. The early months of the vaccination campaign were marked by challenges with scheduling appointments and a shortage of available vaccine doses. More recently - with the recent re-introduction of the Johnson&Johnson vaccine, and walk-in vaccinations at many city-run sites - it has become far easier to get a vaccine.

- 6,494,704 total doses have been administered in New York City
- 53% of NYC residents 18 years and older have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine and 38% are fully vaccinated
- Brooklyn (33%) is the borough with the lowest percentage of people ages 18 years and older who are fully vaccinated

CFLSP provides weekly updates to its directors and Sunset Park-area schools with information on local testing sites, vaccine data, and other relevant resources. Schools regularly forward this information via email or text to their parent networks.
