Connecticut Association of Land Surveyors 2025 Map Design Competition

This is your chance to showcase your talent before your peers!

- 1) The Map Design Competition is open to ALL CALS members. <u>The preparer/drafter or certifying surveyor must be a CALS member.</u>
- 2) All maps must be received at the CALS office no later than Wednesday, October 17, 2025.

 New for 2025 There will be a "live" vote for the "Best in Show" by the attendees at the Annual Meeting.
- 3) All entries must bear an original date before December 1, 2024. Revision dates on the map, which bear the original date earlier than December 1, 2024, are not acceptable.
- 4) All entries must be prepared using: The regulations of State agencies, sections 20-300b-1 through 20-200b-20. / "Standards and Suggested Methods and Procedures for Surveys and Maps in the State of Connecticut". The specific survey type or types **must** be stated in the title. "Property/Boundary Survey" or "Limited Property/Boundary Survey" are **not** survey types. "Resurvey", "Original Survey," or "First Survey" are **not** survey types but Boundary Determination Categories. Maps shall be signed and sealed. Maps not meeting these requirements are subject to disqualification, but may still be displayed.
- 5) Entries shall consist of unmounted prints/plots being standard size (24"x36", 18"x24", or 12"x18" except Presentation Drawings (which shall be no larger than 36"x48") Presentation Drawings shall be in color, and all other entries may be black line, blue line, or in color. Boundary & Construction Stake-Out Sketches and ACOE/DEEP Permit plans/maps may be on 8 ½"x11" or 11"x17" sheets.

 This year, we are accepting PDF's. Your PDF entry must be sent to jussery@jrrusso.com
- 6) Entries may be either hand-drawn or produced by mechanical means.
- 7) All entries must be accompanied by an official entry form and should **not** be folded.
- 8) Entries are limited to two (2) per category. Firms are allowed to enter plans in the same category by different drafters.
- 9) The decisions of the judges are final. Any ties in the judge's scores will be broken by the committee chairperson's vote.
- 10) All maps meeting the minimum eligibility requirements will be mounted and displayed, and the winners will be announced at the annual meeting.
- 11) It shall be the responsibility of the "Best in Competition" winner to forward their entry to the National Competition.

Judging Standards

1) Conformance with Standards & Suggested Methods and procedures for Surveys & Maps in the State of Connecticut, adopted by CALS on August 29, 2019. For example, the specific survey type or types must be stated in the title. (Refer to the Map Rules for Clarification.)
In the event a Presentation Drawing does not meet this standard, it will still be accepted but will lose all points in this scoring category.

2) Content

- Clear interpretation of what a map is intended to depict.
- Technical aspects accuracy levels, attention to detail, monumentation quality, etc.

3) Aesthetic Quality

- Neatness
- Layout
- Proportional scale to plan size
- Artistic influence & originality (line weighing strategy, font/text style variations, symbology, etc.)
- 4) Degree of Difficulty

- 1) Property/Boundary Surveys (Map types listed below are typical)
 - A. Property Surveys
 - B. Perimeter Surveys
- 2) Limited Property/Boundary Surveys
 - A. Existing Building Location Surveys
 - B. Zoning Location Surveys
 - C. Improvement Location Surveys
 - D. Subdivisions / Re-subdivisions
 - E. Boundary Stake-out Sketches/Maps
- 3) Other Miscellaneous Surveys
 - A. Topographic Surveys
 - B. Right-of-Way Surveys
 - C. General Location Surveys
 - D. Compilation Plans
 - E. Data Accumulation Plans
 - F. Construction Stake-out Sketches
 - G. G.I.S. / L.I.S. Layout Plans & G.P.S. Network Control Sketches

4) Presentation Drawings

These drawings cover any of the above-mentioned categories. They must be prepared on a computer and plotter, utilizing color graphics. They must be original drawings. Additionally, there can be no hand drawing, coloring, stick-ons, rub-ons, lettering, etc. These drawings must be a completely automated mapping product. While it is understood that most presentation drawings are not prepared with certifications and appropriate mapping notes, maps that are not submitted meeting those standards will be accepted, but will lose the points allocated under the judging category "Conformance with Standards".


Prizes
