

Commercial Recycling in Anne Arundel County

We Can Help

The Anne Arundel County Recycling and Waste Reduction Division can help county businesses start recycling or improve an existing program. We are available to answer questions, offer literature, and provide technical assistance. Program Specialists are also available for presentations to your staff and for residents of multi-family and apartment complexes.

Community Drop-off Sites

Businesses in Anne Arundel County can drop off an unlimited amount of paper, plastic, metal and glass at any of our Recycling Centers. Businesses may also bring unlimited amounts of cardboard, free of charge, to the Paper Recovery Facility located at the Millersville landfill and Resource Recovery Facility.

Note: Proof that the recycling was generated from a business in Anne Arundel County is required (commercial vehicle registered in Anne Arundel County or a vehicle with commercial logos.)

Private Hauler Recycling Collection

Some businesses may find it in their best interests to obtain recycling services from a private hauler, and most haulers can provide not only your trash collection but your recycling services, as well. If your current trash hauler cannot provide recycling services contact the Anne Arundel County Recycling Division for a list of private haulers that offer recycling services or visit www.MDRcycles.org.

Curbside Recycling Only Collection at Your Business

If your business is interested in having recycling only curbside collection, contact the Recycling Division at 410-222-7951 to discuss your collection options and details of the County's Small Business Recycling Program.

Multi-Family, Apartment & Condo Recycling

Under Maryland law, property owners or managers of apartment buildings or councils of unit owners of condominiums with ten or more dwelling units are required to provide recycling of metal containers, plastic containers, glass containers, and paper for residents, as of October 1, 2014. Details on recycling activities must be reported to the County on an annual basis.

Maryland Recycling Act Report

Let everyone know that you make it your business to recycle. Once a year the Recycling and Waste Reduction Division congratulates the recycling efforts of businesses that reported their recycling and trash volumes to us for the state's annual Maryland Recycling Act report. Businesses also receive a window cling to display that they recycle.
