

PRE-APPRENTICESHIP ELECTRICAL PROGRAM

In partnership with Independent Electrical Contractors Chesapeake (IECC), The Pre-Apprenticeship Electrical program will prepare students to enter and succeed in a Registered Electrical Apprenticeship program.

Students will participate in classroom and online instruction with hands-on lab training at IECC. Students will also obtain OSHA 10, CPR/First Aid Certifications, while preparing for entry into a registered apprenticeship.

Job placement assistance is available upon successful completion of the program.

- Attend an information session
- Take a TABE reading assessment (discussed at information session)
- Have a High school diploma or GED
- Have a valid driver's license
- Have basic computer skills; and daily access to a laptop, desktop or tablet with internet, webcam and audio capabilities
