REEL VOICES: FREE HIGH SCHOOL FILMMAKING PROGRAM ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR SUMMER 2019

Have a great story to tell? Want to learn about documentary filmmaking? Pacific Arts Movement is now accepting applications for our Reel Voices Class of 2019. Apply now!

WHAT IS REEL VOICES? Since 2005, Pacific Arts Movement has empowered local high school students to learn the art of documentary filmmaking. This intense 8-week summer class helps students become socially-conscious storytellers, learn Adobe Premiere editing, and experience all stages of production. Students choose their own topics ranging from identity, family, gender, social issues, school, personal stories, mental health, hopes, dreams, and more.

Students **receive a \$500 scholarship** for their work, which premieres at the annual San Diego Asian Film Festival in November. After, the films are packed on DVD, hosted online, and travel to festivals around the world including Seoul, Montreal, Boston, Los Angeles, Seattle, and New York. Previous Reel Voices students have used their works and awards to earn additional scholarships and apply to film school.

WHO CAN APPLY? The program is free and open to high school students* local to San Diego who want to learn the art of digital storytelling and have open availability in the summer. No filmmaking experience required and equipment will be provided. (*graduating seniors excluded)

CLASS INFO: Every Tuesdays & Thursdays June 18th - August 13th 2019 (8 weeks, off July 4th) from 10:00am - 3:00pm at our office at Liberty Station in Point Loma, San Diego. Please expect to spend 40 additional hours of video editing time in July & August to complete your film. Sundays will also be open for editing sessions.
