



AUTHORIZATION TO SELL CHAMETZ – 5779 (2019)

KNOW ALL PEOPLE BY THESE PRESENTS: that I do hereby make and appoint Rabbi Morris M. Faienstein my true and lawful representative to act on my behalf, to sell all *chametz* owned and possessed, knowingly or unknowingly, as stated in the *Torah* and defined by the sages of Israel (e.g. *chametz*, *chashash chametz* – suspect *chametz* and all kinds of *ta'arovet chametz* – *chametz* mixtures; also, *chametz* that tends to harden and to adhere to the surface of pots, pans, or other cooking or eating utensils, of whatsoever nature, and to lease all places wherein the aforementioned owned or possessed by me maybe found, especially in the premises located at the address below. Rabbi Faienstein has the full authority and power to sell said *chametz* and to lease said places wherein said *chametz* may be found, upon terms and conditions as discretion dictates. Rabbi Faienstein has the full power and authority to assign or appoint a substitute or substitutes to act with all the same powers and authority invested in the rabbi, and I hereby ratify and confirm all that Rabbi Faienstein or a rabbinic substitute lawfully does or causes to be done by virtue of these presents. This transaction will be in effect for the duration of *Pesach*, which this year begins with sundown on Friday, April 19, 2019, and continues through Saturday, April 27, 2019.
