


## Dr. David C Berliner



**About the Speaker:** DAVID C. BERLINER is Regents' Professor Emeritus of Education at Arizona State University. He has taught at the Universities of Arizona and Massachusetts, at Teachers College and Stanford University, as well as universities abroad. Dr. Berliner is a member of the National Academy of Education and the International Academy of Education, a Fellow of the Center for Advanced Study in the Behavioral Sciences, and a past president of both the American Educational Research Association and the Division of Educational Psychology of the American Psychological Association. He has received numerous awards for his distinguished contributions including the Brock award and the AERA award for distinguished contributions to education, the E. L. Thorndike award from the APA for lifetime achievements and the NEA "Friend of Education" award for his work on behalf of the education profession. Berliner has authored more than 300 published articles, chapters and books. Among his best-known works include the book co-authored with B. J. Biddle, *The Manufactured Crisis*, and the book co-authored with Sharon Nichols, *Collateral Damage: How High-Stakes Testing Corrupts American Education*. His most recent book, co-authored with Gene V Glass, is *50 Myths and Lies that Threaten America's Public Schools*.
