of Education, a Fellow of the Center for Advanced Study in the

Behavioral Sciences, and a past president of both the American Educational Research

Association and the Division of Educational Psychology of the American Psychological

Association. He has received numerous awards for his distinguished contributions including

the Brock award and the AERA award for distinguished contributions to education, the E. L.

Thorndike award from the APA for lifetime achievements and the NEA "Friend of Education"

award for his work on behalf of the education profession. Berliner has authored more than

300 published articles, chapters and books. Among his best-known works include the book

co-authored with B. J. Biddle, *The Manufactured Crisis*, and the book co-authored with

Sharon Nichols, *Collateral Damage: How High-Stakes Testing Corrupts American*

Education. His most recent book, co-authored with Gene V Glass, is *50 Myths and Lies that*

Threaten America's Public Schools.
