

The Belfast Museum, 10 Market St., opens for the season on Saturday, June 10. Summer hours are Tuesday through Saturday, 11 a.m. to 4 p.m., through September 9. 2023 marks the 250th anniversary of Belfast's incorporation as a town. Exhibits in the museum reflect its history throughout those 250 years.

Featured exhibits include the 1864 Civil War flag quilt, Perry's Nut House, the William O. Poor apothecary bench, and maritime and industrial history.

In the barn are the old two-cell jail from City Hall, a horse-drawn funeral carriage, a 1960s soap box derby car, and old Belfast business signs. A children's "Be A Museum Detective" activity is available.
