BELFAST, MAINE. In November, the Belfast Bay Watershed Coalition will host a nature outing, a hike up Mt. Waldo in Frankfort on November 5 and the program, “Changing Wildlife and Rivers in Maine” with Ron Joseph at the Belfast Free Library on November 16.

NATURE OUTING

Hike Mt. Waldo with the Belfast Bay Watershed Coalition

Sunday, November 5. Hike up Mt Waldo in Frankfort with the Belfast Bay Watershed Coalition. Mt. Waldo, Kinahpskatenek, *Where there is a big, bouldery mountain*, lives up to its Wabanaki name. The group will hike a short, steep road up to the quarry, climb up rocks to the top of the quarry, and then hike a more moderate path through woods and over open summits to the top. The group will stop for lunch at the top, while admiring the 360 degree view and hike down the same trail. The hike will be approximately 4 hours. Those interested should meet at 10:00 am at the Frankfort Boat Launch on Rt. 1A to caravan to the trailhead. Bring water, lunch, warm layers, rain jacket, hiking poles if these are needed and binoculars. Wear sturdy shoes. Wear orange even though it is Sunday. FMI: 207-338-1147.
