Derosiers' "Therapeutic Play" in the Kramer Gallery for August

"Therapeutic Play" an exhibit of varnished watercolors by Kelly Derosiers will be on display in the Kramer Gallery of the Belfast Free Library through the month of August 2022. The Kramer Gallery located on the ground floor of the library, 106 High St. is open during library hours.

When the pandemic began Unity, Maine artist Kelly Derosiers needed a respite from the anxiety she was feeling. She decided to retreat to her sunny studio and play with colors and shapes, divorced from any intention whatsoever. This exhibit of watercolors is the result of that therapeutic play.

Derosiers, a former teacher of both art and science explores the connections between the disciplines. She states, "Art and science have much in common, despite their different disciplinary cultures. Both are explorations of what is possible. Both investigate and explain a perspective on the world. Both are necessary for a full humanity. Since my art comes from my own full humanity I welcome these connections and share them!"
