**Coastal Mountains Land Trust and Journey to Health Leads Happy Wanderers Hike**

Camden – Join Coastal Mountains Land Trust and Pen Bay Medical Center and Waldo County General Hospital’s Journey to Health program for a *Happy Wanderers Hike* at **10:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 5<sup>th</sup>** at the Hodson Preserve in Camden. This is a 2.2 mile out and back hike, which can be made longer.

**Directions:** From Camden, take Washington Street/Route 105 for 2.5 miles. Turn left onto Molyneaux Road and drive approximately 0.6 miles to the preserve parking area on your right.

The Happy Wanderers meet on the first Thursday of each month at the trailhead of a Coastal Mountains Land Trust preserve. The hikes range in location from Rockport to Searsport. Each outing is led by a Coastal Mountains and a Journey to Health staff member. We hope you can join the adventure!
