We're starting to see the bottom of our storage crop bins but still have plenty of our own carrots, beets, parsnips, garlic, potatoes, and cabbage available at the farm stand. It won't be long until the spring greens are coming in!

It felt important for us to share the news that we recently sent a sample from our well to be tested for the presence of PFAS chemicals, otherwise known as "forever chemicals." Thankfully, the results came back showing our water to be free from PFAS chemical contamination. Due to the recent discovery of PFAS contamination on some farmland in Maine, we felt it was important for our own peace of mind, and for our customers to know if our land was one of the sites affected by PFAS. Our hearts and thoughts are often with farmer friends of ours whose land and/or water has been affected by these 'forever chemicals'. It feels more important than ever to be a good steward of this land and work with it to provide as much safe and beautiful food for our community as we can.
