Mid-coast Attorney to Hear Arguments in Admiralty Moot Court Competition

On March 31 in the Cumberland County Courthouse, Waldoboro attorney Andrew Zulieve will sit as one of the Supreme Court Justices in the Judge John R. Brown Admiralty Moot Court Competition. Thirty-four teams from across the U.S. will present arguments in *Arthur Sewall & Co. v. Murphy*. The Court will consider two issues: (1) whether a pilot qualifies as a traditional seaman protected by the warranty of seaworthiness, and (2) whether a pilot may rely on the holding in the U.S. Supreme Court case of *Seas Shipping v. Sieracki* to maintain an action for unseaworthiness. For the past several years, Attorney Zulieve has participated in various mock trials in Maine.
