Quick Bible Summary Since Last Sunday (Genesis 11:27 - Genesis 18)

Gen. 11 – Abram's father, Terah, took his family and left Ur (Babylon) to go to Haran (Assyria). Abram married Sarai.

- Gen. 12 God called Abram and Sarai to leave Haran to go to Canaan (Holy Land). They went with their nephew, Lot. There was a famine, so they fled to Egypt. They tricked Pharaoh. Egypt was punished with plagues. Pharaoh got angry and kicked them out of Egypt.
- Gen. 13 Abram and Sarai settled in the desert. They grew in wealth and power. Abram and Lot separated.
- ❖ Gen. 14 An alliance of tribal kings went to war. Lot is captured. Abram and his men went to war against the tribal kings. Lot is rescued. The Canaanite Priestly King Melchizedek appeared to Abram and Abram gave 1/10 of his possessions, the tithe.
- ❖ Gen. 15 The Covenant with Abram and Sarai was established.
- ❖ Gen. 16 Sarai was barren; she gave consent for Abram to go have children with Hagar, their slave girl. Ishmael was born. Sarai was consumed with jealousy and treated Hagar harshly. Hagar fled with her baby. The LORD comforted Hagar.
- Gen. 17 The Covenant with Abram and Sarai; they get renamed Abraham and Sarah. God promised them the land of Canaan and that they would have many offspring.
- ❖ Gen. 18 A son is promised to Abraham and Sarah Isaac.
