Please join us each Sunday as we explore these five new ways to pray. You don't need to order the book, but you may of course order a copy online if you'd like to have your own.

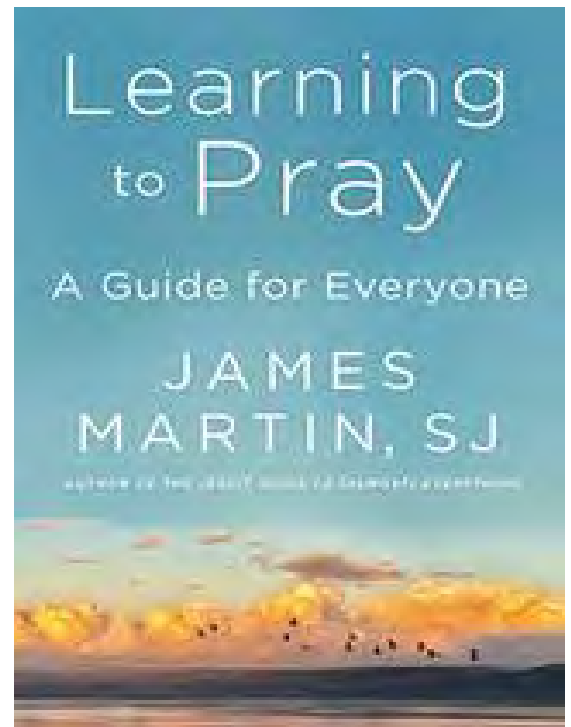

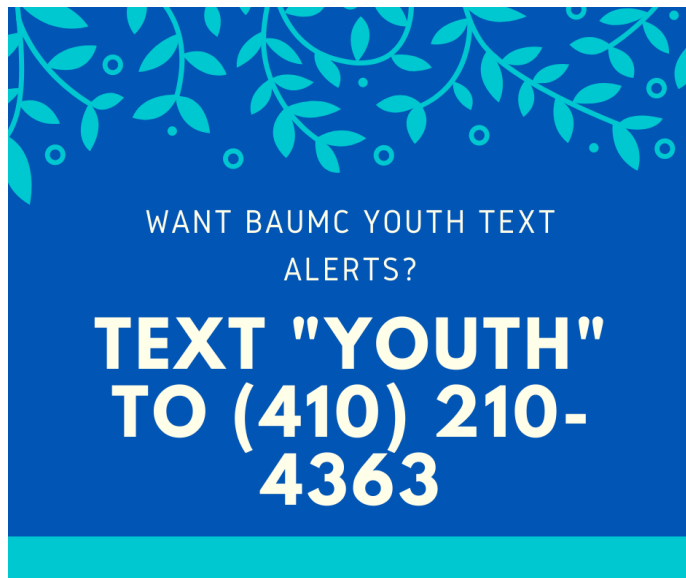

We have found that often it is in relationship that a person's perspective changes. Hearing the grief in the voice of someone who has lived through injustices has increased real awareness.

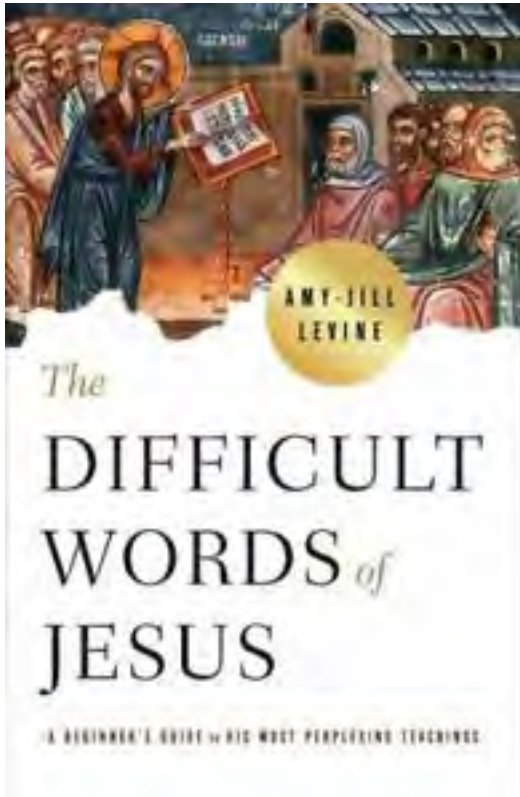


Upon reflection, we look at how our God wanted to reconcile people to himself and to each other and did so not with a book, video, or tweet, but by sending his Son in human form to be in relationship with us. Reconciliation is relational. We believe that bringing people together can build friendships which lead to looking at the forces that led to separation in the first place and then can motivate all toward positive change.

On the third Sunday of the month, The Family worships together at one of our three churches. On September 19, the group will be worshipping at BAUMC. Also, The Family meets once a month on a designated Thursday evening to connect, educate and advocate.

Additionally, just the BAUMC Racial Justice team meets monthly to enhance our understanding of racial issues and will be meeting Tuesday, September 21, 7PM in the church library. The Difficult Words of Jesus- by Dr. Amy-Jill Levine

The Covenant Small Group invites you to study with us as we examine some of the most difficult teachings of Jesus in a 6-week session.

Jesus provided his disciples teachings for how to follow God's word; he told them parables to help them discern questions of ethics and of human nature; he offered them beatitudes for comfort and encouragement. But sometimes Jesus spoke words that followers then and now have found difficult. He instructs disciples to hate members of their own families (Luke 14:26), to act as if they were slaves (Matthew 20:27), and to sell their belongings and give to the poor (Luke 18:22). He restricts his mission (Matthew 10:6); he speaks of damnation (Matthew 8:12); he calls Jews the devil's children (John 8:44).

Dr. Levine shows how these difficult teachings would have sounded to the people who first heard them, how have they been understood over time, and how we might interpret them in the context of the Gospel.

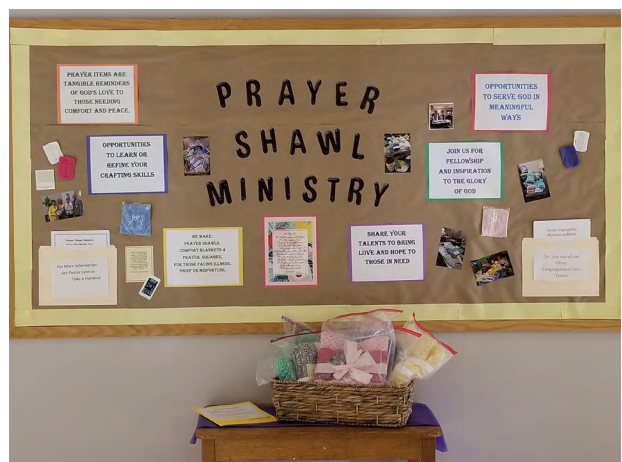
